Objective and strategy

Xtrackers MSCI Japan Hedged Equity ETF seeks investment results that correspond generally to the performance, before fees and expenses, of the MSCI Japan U.S. Dollar Hedged Index. The Index is designed to provide exposure to Japanese equity markets, while at the same time mitigating exposure to fluctuations between the value of the U.S. dollar and Japanese yen.



³ Price-to-book ratio is a valuation ratio of a stock's market value compared to its book value.

⁴ Price-to-earnings ratio (P/E) is a stock's current price divided by the company's trailing 12-month earnings per share from continuous operations.

⁵ Dividend yield is a weighted-sum of the annualized dividends of the index components divided by the most recent index value. Annualized dividends are determined using a sum of all dividend announcements during the previous 12 months. Dividend yield is that of the MSCI Japan Index and is the rate of income generated by a stock in the form of dividends. The dividend yield of the index should not be considered the dividend yield of the fund.
